THE STUDENT COMMONS

The Student Commons will meet the needs of a growing high school community by bringing a modern library, an expanded dining hall and kitchen, and a comfortable student lounge to the Upper Campus.

At 12,590-square feet, this beautiful two-story building will create, for the first time, a central gathering place for students and faculty to enjoy meals together. The design by Los Angeles architect Frederick Fisher & Partners embraces the mid-century roots of the Upper Campus and blurs the lines between inside and outside using glass, stucco, warm wood accents, and ample landscaping.

When completed in 2020, the Commons will improve student life by providing a first-class dining facility for the entire community and create a new center for collaborative learning.

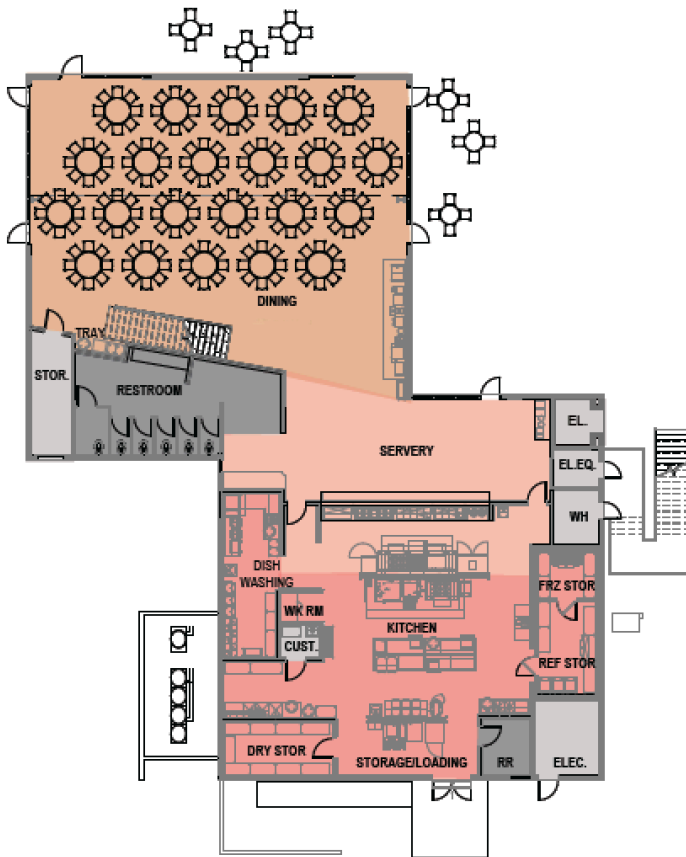

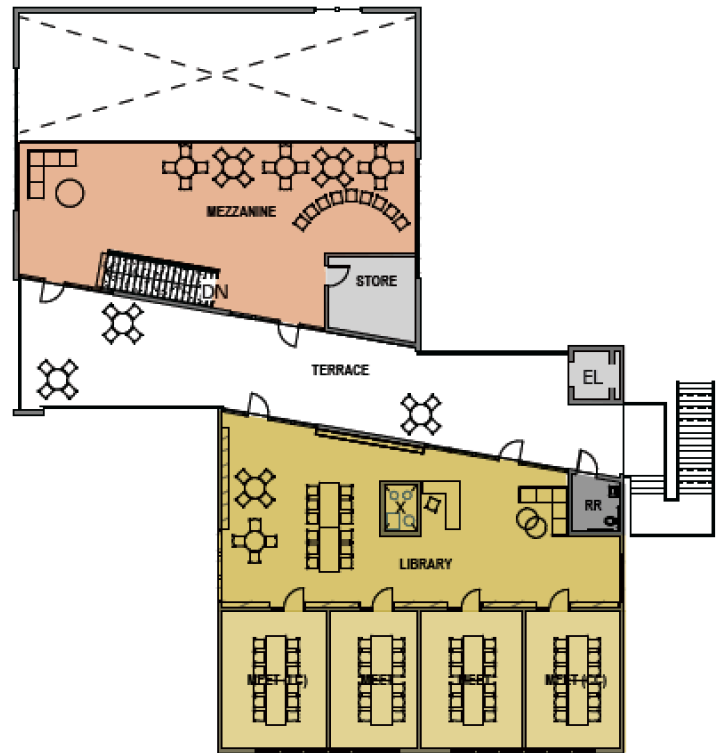
